Douglas Ridge Rifle Club Late Renewal and Rejoining Procedure

Purpose: Establishes procedures for members who renew their memberships late and former members who wish to rejoin.

Scope: Applies to all members and former members.

Procedure:

1. Definitions

- Late renewal member is any member who pays after the renewal due date as specified in the by-laws and prior to the end of the membership year.
- Rejoining member is any member who has not renewed their membership for one or more membership years.
- Any member who renews past the established due date will be responsible for full dues and all fees regardless of date of renewal. There will be no proration of dues or fees for a late renewal. Late renewing members will retain credit for continuous membership without break and any related benefits.
- A former member wishing to rejoin will be considered for membership upon submission of a completed application. If accepted the former member may be accepted as a member under the following conditions.
 - Must complete an application form.
 - Was a member in good standing at the time they resigned their former membership.
 - Will not retain any prior status or position as a result of years of membership or service from their former membership.
 - Will rejoin as a new member subject to all dues and fees less the initiation fee. Rejoining members will be eligible for any current dues or fees proration.
 - If has not been a member for 3 or more years they will be required to attend a new member orientation.
