Targets - Only paper targets (and steel reactionary at the silhouette range) are allowed on DRRC firing ranges. There are exceptions to this rule for some disciplines and some ranges. Do not use cans, bottles, plastic jugs, etc. as targets.

Failure to follow DRRC rules could result in disciplinary action. The Board reminds all members that we are self-policing, and if

you observe someone breaking our rules, ask them to stop and get their name and member number. Report rule infractions to the Discipline Director, Range Safety Officer, Range Host, or a Board Member.
